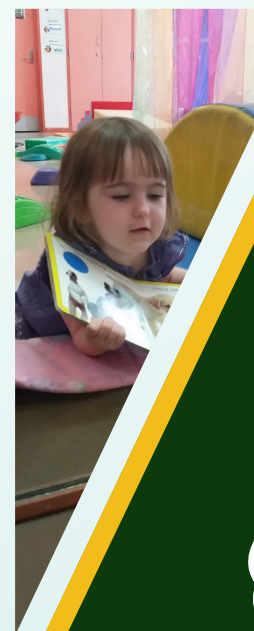
Ipswich Ollies ECDP is co-located on the grounds of Ipswich Special School.
